

CORPORATE TRANSPARENCY ACT- FILING REQUIREMENT SUSPENDED (AGAIN)

Appeals Court Reversal Restores CTA Injunction, Re-suspends Filing Requirement

On December 26, 2024 (yesterday), the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit vacated its December 23, 2024 stay relating to the Corporate Transparency Act ("CTA"). Reporting companies are again *not* required to file Beneficial Ownership Information (BOI) reports with FinCEN. Yesterday's ruling in effect reinstated the December 3, 2024 preliminary injunction barring the enforcement of the CTA.
