We invite qualified law students to apply to our annual Diversity Scholars Program. Members of historically underrepresented groups in the legal profession are encouraged to apply but membership in such groups is not a requirement or factor in selection. One Diversity Scholar will be selected, complete a summer associate position of 6-8 weeks at our Washington, D.C. office, and participate in mentoring with our partners and associates, among other opportunities. The weekly salary for the Diversity Scholars Program is determined based on our first-year associate salary, which is currently \$225,000 per year.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion in the legal profession
- Outstanding academic achievement
- Demonstrated interest in a career in tax, benefits and compensation, or estate planning
- First-year student in a J.D. program at an ABA-accredited law school
- U.S. citizen or authorization to work in the United States

## Selection Criteria

• A combination of commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion in the legal profession; academic and professional achievement; and interest in IPB's practice areas.

Timeline for the 2025 Diversity Scholars Program

- December 1, 2024: Application period begins
- January 31, 2025: Deadline to submit applications
- February-March 2025: Interviews and final selection

- Cover letter
- Resume
- Law school transcript, supplemented as needed when you receive 1L fall grades
- A statement up to 500 words of your qualifications for the Program
- A legal writing sample up to 10 pages
